

Wajib Sajadat

There are four wajib sajadat in the Qur'an, on hearing or reciting them one must perform a sajda. It is not necessary to face qibla, or be in wudhoo. The only condition is that the sajda must be done on a sajadaga, earth or any other thing on which sajda is allowed. As for wajib sajadat the ayaat are marked in the Qur'an with the word sajda.

The sajadat are in the following ayaat :

إِنَّمَا يُؤْمِنُ بِآيَاتِنَا الَّذِينَ
إِذَا ذُكِّرُوا بِهَا خَرُّوا سُجَّدًا
وَسَبَّحُوا بِحَمْدِ رَبِّهِمْ وَهُمْ
لَا يَسْتَكْبِرُونَ

RECOMMENDED RECITATION IN SAJDA

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ حَقًّا حَقًّا

There is no god but Allah and

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ إِيْمَانًا وَ تَصْدِيْقًا

There is no God but Allah in
whom I believe and testify to

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ عُبُوْدِيَّةً وَرِقًّا

There is no god but Allah in
whom I submit and am a slave of

سَجَدْتُ لَكَ يَا رَبِّي تَعْبُدًا وَرِقًّا

I prostrate for you O my Rabb
with submission and as Your Slave

لَا مُسْتَنْكِفًا وَلَا مُسْتَكْبِرًا

With no rejection or arrogance

بَلْ أَنَا عَبْدٌ ذَلِيْلٌ ظَعِيْفٌ خَائِفٌ مُسْتَجِيْرٌ

In fact I am your slave who is
lowly, weak, fearful and needful
of Your protection.
