

# Sajadat of Tilawat Quran



There are four wajib sajdah in the Qur'an (on hearing or reciting the following 4 ayaat one must perform a sajdah). It is not necessary to face qibla, or be in wudhoo...

The sajdah are in the following ayaat:

32:15	<b>Sajdah</b>	Juz 21
41:38	<b>HaMim Sajda</b>	Juz 24
53:62	<b>Najm</b>	Juz 27
96:19	<b>Alaq</b>	Juz 30

**Memorisation Sentence**

**Sajadah Are Highly Necessary**

Although there is no need for any recitation it is recommended to recite the following in sajdah:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ حَقًّا حَقًّا  
لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ إِيْمَانًا وَ تَصْدِيقًا  
لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ عُبُودِيَّةً وَرِقًّا  
سَجَدْتُ لَكَ يَا رَبِّي تَعْبُدًا وَرِقًّا  
لَا مُسْتَنْكِفًا وَلَا مُسْتَكْبِرًا  
بَلْ أَنَا عَبْدٌ ذَلِيلٌ ظَعِيفٌ خَائِفٌ مُسْتَجِيرٌ

La ilaha illal lahu haqqan haqqa;  
La ilaha illal lahu imanaw wa tasdiqa;  
la ilaha illal lahu 'ubdiyyatan wa riqqa;  
Sajadtu laka ya Rabbi,  
ta'abbudan wa riqqa  
la mustankifan wa la mustak biran  
Bal anaa 'abdun zalilun zha'ifun khaa'ifun  
mustajeer.

There are 10 mustahab sajdah in the Qur'an (on hearing or reciting the ayaat it is recommended that one performs sajdah). The 10 ayaat with mustahab sajdah are:

7:206	13:15	16:50	17:109	19:58
22:18	25:60	27:26	38:24	84:21

The beginning of the ayaat of sajdah is often marked with and the end of the ayaat where one does sajdah is marked with



# Signs to observe when reciting the Qur'an



م	MUST STOP
ج ط	SHORT STOP
قف ق	ADVISABLE STOP
ص	PERMISSIBLE STOP
0	STOP (End of aya)
صل ز	SHOULD NOT STOP
لا	MUST NOT STOP

When two signs appear at the same place in the middle of the aya; the top one prevails
