

# Mustahab Duas while performing Wudhoo

**On seeing the water:** In the name of Allah, and for the sake of Allah.  
All praise is for Allah, Who made the water Tahir and not Najis.

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَيَا اللَّهُ وَالْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي جَعَلَ الْمَاءَ طَهُورًا وَلَمْ يَجْعَلْهُ نَجَسًا

**While washing the hands till wrists:** O Allah! Make me of those who ask for forgiveness and who purify themselves.

اللَّهُمَّ اجْعَلْنِي مِنَ التَّوَّابِينَ وَاجْعَلْنِي مِنَ الْمُتَطَهِّرِينَ

**While gargling the mouth:** O Allah! Dictate to me the correct answer on the day I meet You,  
and make my tongue fluent with Your remembrance.

اللَّهُمَّ لَقْنِي حُجَّتِي يَوْمَ الْقَاكِ وَأَطْلِقْ لِسَانِي بِذِكْرِكَ

**While rinsing the nose:** O Allah! Do not deprive me of the Fragrance of Janna,  
and make me of those who smell its fragrance, its refreshment and its essence.

اللَّهُمَّ لَا تُحَرِّمْ عَلَيَّ رِيحَ الْجَنَّةِ وَاجْعَلْنِي مِمَّنْ يَشْتُمُّ رِيحَهَا وَرَوْحَهَا وَطِيبَهَا

**While washing the face:** O Allah! Brighten my face on the day the faces are darkened,  
and do not darken my face on the day the faces are brightened.

اللَّهُمَّ بَيِّضْ وَجْهِي يَوْمَ تَسْوَدُ فِيهِ الْوُجُوهُ وَلَا تُسَوِّدْ وَجْهِي يَوْمَ تَبْيَضُ فِيهِ الْوُجُوهُ

**While washing the right forearm:** O Allah! Give me my book of deeds in my right hand and the right of  
permanent abode in Jannah, and make my accounting easy.

اللَّهُمَّ أَعْطِنِي كِتَابِي بِيَمِينِي وَالْخُلْدَ فِي الْجَنَّةِ بِيَسَارِي وَحَاسِبِنِي حِسَابًا يَسِيرًا

**While washing the left forearm:** O Allah! Do not give me my book of deeds in my left hand,  
nor from behind my back, nor hang it around my neck. I seek refuge in You from the fire.

اللَّهُمَّ لَا تُعْطِنِي كِتَابِي بِشِمَالِي وَلَا مِنْ وَرَاءِ ظَهْرِي وَلَا تَجْعَلْهَا مَعْلُومَةً إِلَى عُنُقِي  
وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ مُقَطَّعَاتِ النَّيِّرَانِ

**While performing the masah of the Head:** O Allah! Cover me with Your Mercy, Blessings and Pardon.

اللَّهُمَّ غَشِّنِي بِرَحْمَتِكَ وَبَرَكَاتِكَ وَعَفْوِكَ

**While performing the masah of the feet:** O Allah! Keep me steady on the 'sirat' on the day when feet shall slip,  
and make my efforts please You. O Master of Power and Honour.

اللَّهُمَّ تَبَيَّنِي عَلَى الصِّرَاطِ يَوْمَ تَنْزَلُ فِيهِ الْأَقْدَامُ وَاجْعَلْ سَعْيِي فِي مَا يُرْضِيكَ عَنِّي  
يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ وَالْأَكْرَامِ
