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A plenary is a short 5 minute activity at the end of the lesson to review the aims of the lesson and consolidate the students learning.

STEPS TO SUCCESSFUL LESSON PLANNING

1. Think about your class (age group/abilities/type of learners)
2. Outline learning objectives and key words
3. Plan the learning episodes
4. Plan to check for understanding
5. Create a realistic timeline

EXAMPLE LESSON PLAN

TOPIC: SAYYIDA FATIMA

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- To have an overview of the life of Sayyida Fatima
- To focus on the words of Imam Ali's at Sayyida Fatima's grave, and to discuss its application to your life

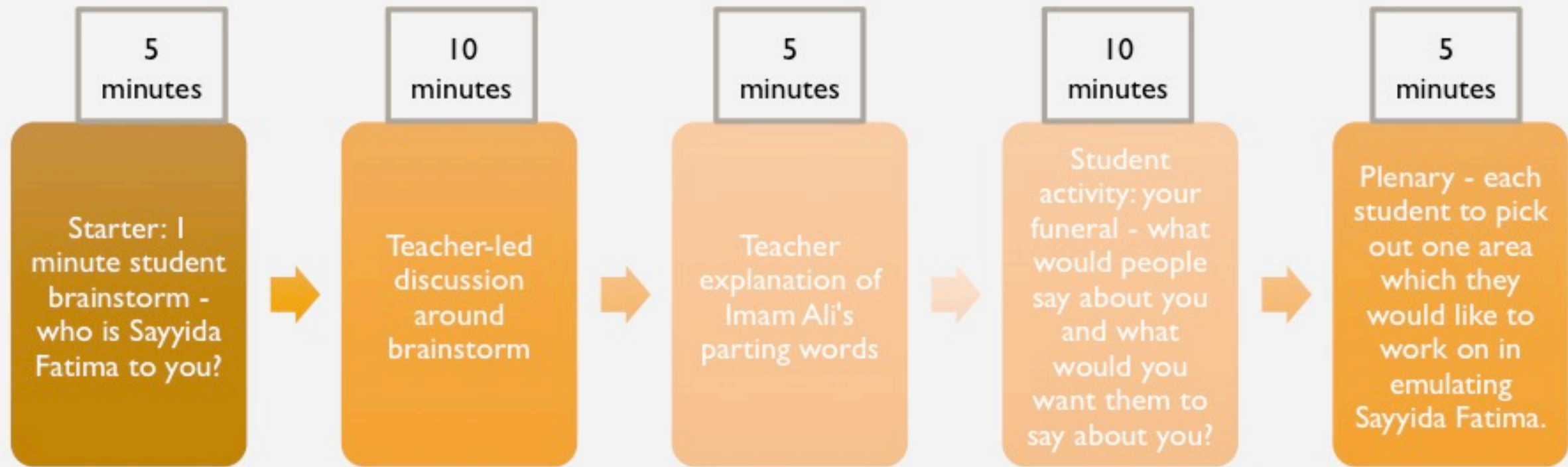
