Sura Al-Baqara 286 ayaat

$$\frac{286}{2} = 143 \text{ (Middle of Sura)}$$

Raised again by Prophet Ibraheem & Ismail (pbuh)

Starting point of Me'raj (Wal Isra')

Subsequent permanent Qibla

- ① Visible focal point of orientation.
- ② Success is orientation towards Divinity through contemplation, reflection and Salaa.
- ③ Outwardly – Masjidul Haram
Inwardly – The inner ❤️
"THE HEAVENS AND EARTH DO NOT CONTAIN ME, BUT THE OF THE BELIEVER CONTAINS ME." ❤️
- ④ Wherever one is, whatever the circumstance, inner intention and outer practice must be orientated towards the Rabb.
- ⑤ Unites Muslims of diverse places and different times to fix their attention to one point.
- ⑥ The Qibla portrays the one belief of Muslims connected to each other in a radiating structure.
