### ELABORATE

Literally means 'the son of the path'... Someone who is constantly travelling and cannot afford to or is unable to live in a permanent home.

The homeless and refugees\* come to mind.

A refugee, generally speaking, is one who has been forced to leave his home country and is unable to return there in safety.

It is our duty to identify such people and take the opportunity to help them.

### STATISTICS

An unprecedented 65.6 million people around the world have been forced out from their homes. Among them are nearly 22.5 million refugees, over half of whom are under the age of 18.

There are also 10 million stateless people who have been denied a nationality and access to basic rights such as education, healthcare, employment and freedom of movement.
