Discuss the concept of Qibla

1. Visible focal point of orientation.
2. Success is orientation towards Divinity through contemplation, reflection and Salaa.
3. Wherever one is, whatever the circumstance, inner intention and outer practice must be orientated towards the Rabb.
4. Unites Muslims of diverse places and different times to fix their attention to one point.
5. The Qibla portrays the one belief of Muslims connected to each other in a radiating structure.
