They came across a section called HAWAMEEM. The buildings shone like jewels and there was a beautiful smell coming from them. "I wonder what these are?" he thought to himself.




Just then Hizqeel said "Here we are – Suratu Maryam building"

"Are you all right?" Qaswa asked


The old man didn't answer. He made a sign asking Qaswa to do tasbeeh.


Qaswa strained his neck to see the baby.




THIRD FLOOR






"Why are they sad?" he asked Hizqeel.
"They are not sad" "This happens when you understand the truth and love God". "They are tears of love of God" Hizqeel said.


On the wall the plaque said ayaat 41-58


Qaswa nudged the door open and said 'Wow' There was a beautiful garden with the most

ESCAPE FOR THOSE WHO DO GOOD


SEVENTH FLOOR

I will always read and follow the Qur'an - he promised himself.




Qaswa's eyes opened and he was under the palm tree. He couldn't wait to tell Safiya about his adventure to Quran City and visiting Building No 19.

Maryam is the only woman in the Qur'an who is mentioned by name. (34x). Ja'fer Al Tayyar recited Ayaat 1-40 in the court of King Najashi of Abyssinia when he called the Muslims to his court upon the extradition request of the Quraysh.
