6 OATHS INVITATION TO REFLECT

Sun Moon | Day Night | Heaven Earth
All opposites but each has a limit and a discipline which
brings harmony.

Following discipline gives harmony. Reflect & apply to oneself.



وَنَفْسٍ وَمَا سَوّاهَا

And the soul and Him Who made it perfect,

Sawwa comes from taswiya – to take things that are unbalanced and to balance them. No Al like the others-Refelct on the nafs & its amazing balance(He who balanced it). Ruh from the 'amr of Allah-His sustenance can only come from revelation. Eiman & Revelation = Nur.

Nurun alaa nur





فَأَهْمَهَا فُجُورَهَا وَتَقُواهَا

Then He inspired it to understand what is right and wrong for it;

Ilhaam - Gut feeling, something one is sure about (gift from God)

Fujur – (Fajr) – Tears open

Faajir – Rebels in worse possible way. Clear knowledge of rebellion

Taqwaha – Protects itself (from harm and punishment. In built recognition of evil and good Conflict – **LAWWAMA** (disturbed)

MUTMAINNA (content) Programmed to recognise evil & protection.

Guilty conscience - Wiqaya





He will indeed be successful who purifies it,

Aflahaa from Iflaah – farmer about to reap harvest
Fujur – Anger, hatred, jealousy, resentment
Realises fujur and engaging in cleansing



وَقُلُ خَابِ مَن رَسَّاهَا

And he will indeed fail who corrupts it.

Khaabaa – running after something – failed to get it or it wasn't what you were looking for.

Dassaa – one who completely disregarded the nafs





Thamood gave the lie (to the truth) in their inordinacy,

Subject switches to a nation
Thamood lied against their then prophet as a result of their rebellion.

Corrupt not as a lack of knowledge.





When the most unfortunate of them broke forth with

The people of Thamood were a powerful knowledgeable nation known to the Quraysh.

The reference to a corrupt leadership as those of Thamood who led them to destruction.

Most audacious —the loudest of them — I WILL TAKE IT ON.



فَقَالَ لَمُ مُ سُولُ اللهِ نَاقَةَ اللهِ وَسُقِياهَا

So Allah's messenger said to them (Leave alone) Allah's she-camel, and (give) her (to) drink.

Prophet Salih (pbuh) warned them Quraysh listening – they called him a liar. Suqyaha – Its place and time of drinking





But they called him a liar and slaughtered her,

They called Prophet Salih (pbuh) a liar and disregarded him 'Aqar – a slow death (cut off the camels legs)



فَلَمْلَمَ عَلَيْهِمْ مَا يُهُم بِنَانِهِمْ فَسَوَّاهَا

Therefore their Rabb crushed them for their sin and levelled them (with the ground). (Pounded and crushed until it becomes part of the ground).

Zhanab – Tail of an animal. That which should have made you ashamed. ("tail between his legs' – humiliating)Sawwa – Balanced it to the ground





And He fears not its consequence.

Sura about one who doesn't fear consequences

Defies the messenger and kills signs

Divinity executes justice – doesn't fear anyone's comments
Opinion of creation doesn't affect Him
