

NARRATIVE

THE CHAPTER BEGINS WITH THE PROPHETS CALL TO THE MAKKANS TO THE BASIS OF FAITH AND A WARNING TO THE PUNISHMENT IF THEY TURN AWAY. IT ADDRESSES THE DIFFICULTIES THE PROPHET ENCOUNTERED IN THEIR REJECTION OF RESURRECTION, THEIR ANIMOSITY TOWARDS HIM, THEIR OUTRAGEOUS DEMANDS AND THEIR ACCUSATIONS THAT THE QUR'AN WAS FABRICATED.

IT THEN TRANSITIONS TO RECOUNTING THE STORIES OF THE PROPHETS AND SERVES TO CONSOLE THE PROPHET IN THE MAKKAN ENVIRONEMNT WHERE THERE WAS GROWING HOSTILITY TOWARDS HIM ESPECIALLY AFTER THE PASSING AWAY OF ABU TALIB AND SAYYID KHADIJA.

IT DEMONSTRATES HOW ALL THE PROPHETS WENT THROUGH DIFFICULT TRIALS BUT WITH PERSEVERENCE AND PATIENCE THEY WERE ABLE TO OVERCOME THOSE WHO OPPOSED THEM.
