QUALITIES OF ONE WHO TRULY BELIEVES CONTRASTED TO THOSE WHO DENY DIVINE GUIDANCE AND RESURRECTION

'Yaa Ayyuhal lazheena Aamenu" is addressed to all kinds of believers - those who truly believe, those on the fence and those who profess belief but do not believe in themselves. Al Mu'minun refers to those who believe with heart and soul and manifest it in their actions.

23:62	Responsibility according to
23:96	Repel evil with what is best
23:115	Return to Allah

The chapter begins by citing the qualities of one who truly believes.

It then moves to a reflection on the creation of the human being from clay, recounting his development from a clot through to his death and resurrection.

After several verses on the blessings of Divinity, the chapter transitions to guidance through past Messengers with a focus on Prophet Nuh, Musa, Harun & Isa (pbut) and a mention of generations in between.

Further qualities of those who believe is followed by the arrogance of those who deny Divinity and their mental cages.

The sura concludes with a dua of asking for forgiveness and mercy.
