



TREE BRANCHES




A tree with just roots is not a complete tree. In order for it to be complete, it needs branches too.

In the same way Islam is a complete way of life composed of both beliefs and a'mal – actions.





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TREE BRANCHES



The branches of religion, called furu, portray the a'mal - actions (deeds) required to be performed by a Muslim

The laws of Islam by which one can perform the furu is known as Shari'a.

There are 10 branches (furu) of religion.










SALAA



Salaa is a pillar of religion which connects the soul to Allah.

..."Indeed Salaa keeps (one) away from indecency and evil...." 29:45









SAWM




Sawm means to keep away from certain things from dawn to sunset only for Allah. Every Muslim who has reached buloogh must fast in the month of Ramadhan.

"O you who believe! Sawm (Fasting) has been ordained for you as it was ordained for those before you so that you may have taqwa." 2:183










HAJJ



Every year in the month of Dhulhijja, Muslims from all over the world go for Hajj if they can.

....."And only for Allah; It is incumbent on people, the Hajj (Pilgrimage) to the House, for those who are able to undertake (afford.....) the journey....." 3:97





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ZAKAA



Zakaa is an Islamic tax. Tax means sharing your wealth with other members of the society.

وَآقِيْمُوْ الصَّلَاةَ وَاتُّوْ الرَّكَاةَ

"And establish salaa and give zakaa...." 2:43





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KHUMS



The word Khums means one fifth. It is a tax like Zakaa. Its name implies that you have to pay one fifth on which it applies.

Khums becomes wajib when you become baligh.

"And know that whatever you acquire, a fifth of it is for Allah and for His Prophet and (the Prophet's) near relations, and the orphans and the needy and the wayfarer...." 8:41










JIHAD



Jihad is often translated as 'holy war'. However, it is much more than that. It literally means to 'work hard' or 'to strive' for something.

اَمْ حَسِبْتُمْ اَنْ تَلْخُلُوا الْجُنَّةَ وَلَمَّا يَعْلَمِ اللهُ الَّذِينَ جَاهَلُوا مِنْكُمْ المُّا الْمُنْكُمُ المَّابِرِينَ وَيَعْلَمَ الصَّابِرِينَ

"Do you reckon you will enter Janna when Allah knows those of you who do jihaad from you and those who are Saabir (patient, steadfast)" 3:142









AMR BIL MA'RUF & NAHIY ANIL MUNKAR



Amr bil Ma'ruf means to encourage righteousness. Nahyi anil Munkar means to discourage someone from doing things that are haram.

وَلْتُكُنُ مِنْكُمْ أُمَّةٌ يَلُعُونَ إِلَى الْخَيْرِ وَيَأْمُوُ وَنَ بِالْمَعُرُ وَنِ وَيَنْهَوْنَ عَنْ الْمُنْكُرِ وَأُولَئِكُمْ أُمُّنُكُمْ الْمُفْلِحُونَ عَنِ الْمُنْكَرِ وَأُولَئِكُمْ أُلْفُلِحُونَ

TAWALLA



Tawalla means to love and follow the teachings of the Prophet (Pbuh) and his Ahlulbayt.

..."Say! I do not ask of you of any reward except love for my near relations..." 42:23










TABARRA



Tabarra means to keep away from those who are the enemies of Allah, His Prophet and the Ahlulbayt. It also means keeping away from those who do evil.

يَا أَيُّهَا الَّذِينَ امَّنُو الْاتَّتَّخِذُو اعَدُوِّي وَعَدُوَّ كُمْ أَوْلِيّاءَ

"O you who believe! Do not take My enemy and your enemy as friends..." 60:1





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
