



The sura is also known as Al Saakhkha (The piercing cry) or Al Safraah (The Scribes)

The sura reinforces the message of Sura Al Naaziaat 79:45 "You are a warner only to the one who fears it (Accountability) "

The Prophet wished the guidance to reach even the elite of the Quraysh who considered themselves independent of the Creator and the messenger and saw the Muslims as rebels who were threatening their way of life.










The sura begins with admonition to the frowning towards the blind believer (Abdullah ibn Ummi Maktum) who interrupted the meeting of the Prophet with the leaders of the Quraysh. The blind man could not see this so he wasn't directly offended; however Allah mandates respect to him and rebukes the very elite who thought they were doing the Prophet a favour by giving him their time.



The Qur'an is sacred, classified, and purified scripture whose scribes are honoured, pious and just which benefits only those who want to reach their full potential.














NARRATIVE



The first ten verses refer to an incident regarding a blind man called Abdullah ibn Umm Maktum who was one of the first Muslims. He taught the Qur'an to many people and was a Muadhdhin. The Prophet trying to protect the Muslims from harassment from the Quraysh elite, had a meeting with them to convince them to submit to Divinity. The blind man interrupted the meeting and the elite expressed their discomfort. Allah admonishes them.










NARRATIVE

It then transitions into reflection on the bounties provided by Divinity concluding with a reminder of the contrasting fate of those who believe versus those who defiantly rebel against Allah.


