THE PROPHET TRYING TO PROTECT THE MUSLIMS FROM HARASSMENT FROM THE QURAYSH ELITE, HAD A MEETING WITH THEM TO CONVINCE THEM TO SUBMIT TO DIVINITY.

THE BLIND MAN INTERRUPTED THE MEETING AND THE ELITE EXPRESSED THEIR DISCOMFORT. ALLAH ADMONISHES THEM.
THE CHAPTER CONTINUES TO THE BOOK OF RECORDS WRITTEN BY THE ANGELS AND THE QUR'AN AS A POWERFUL REMINDER.

IT THEN TRANSITIONS INTO REFLECTION ON THE BOUNTIES PROVIDED BY DIVINITY CONCLUDING WITH A REMINDER OF THE CONTRASTING FATE OF THOSE WHO BELIEVE VERSUS THOSE WHO DEFIANTLY REBEL AGAINST ALLAH.
