# FIRST NIGHT OF RAJAB

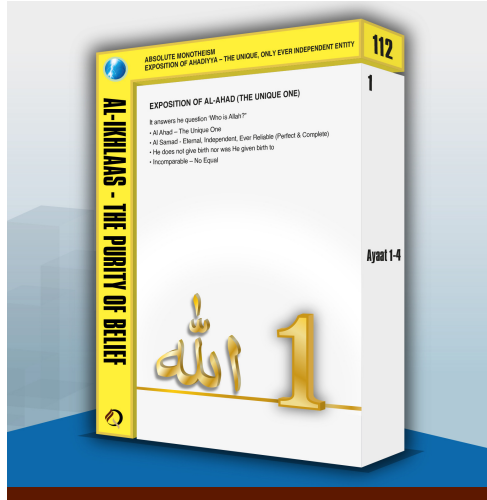
On sighting the moon of Rajab, the Holy Prophet (pbuh) used to pray saying,
