Who is that saviour?



- On card, write your name in Arabic, with it's meaning, decorate it and stick it on your bedroom door.



















LIFE IN THE PALACE



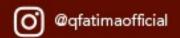
BEYOND THE PALACE GATES, ONE DREADFUL DAY...

Musa tried to help him and he pushed the enemy away, who fell, hit his head on a rock and died.








- 3. Highlight the three Asma ul Husna in the above verse.











DUA OF MUSA 28: 16-17





He also saw two women standing by the side with their flock.







- He has full trust in his Lord that whatever will come down to him will be good.


















MUSA MEETS PROPHET SHUAIB (PBUH)

Prophet Shuaib (pbuh) offered Musa a job; with a contract for 8 years and if Musa completed 10 years it would be better. He also offered Musa his daughter in marriage.


