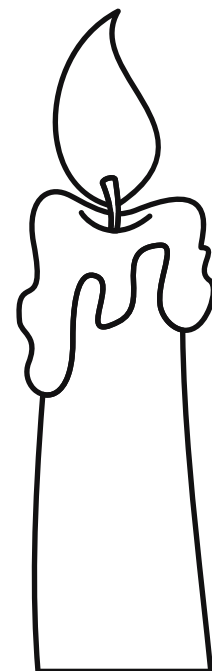

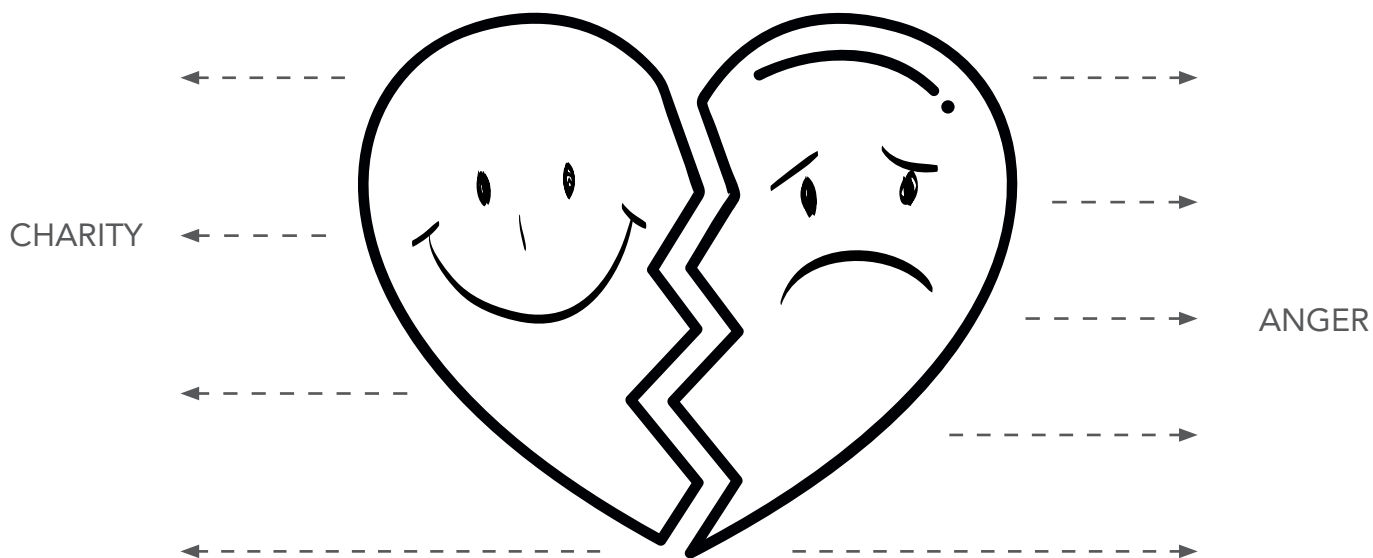
On the above pie chart, shade in each of the segments along the marked lines on a scale of 0-10 to rate how ANGER affects you in each area of your life.
