The names are a medicine for the wounded parts of the heart and soul.

One of the ways to use this book is to study each Asmaul Husna in order from beginning to end. Another way is to simply open the book and go wherever it takes you. There are many different ways to translate Arabic. There is no standard way but we hope the form we have chosen is easy to use.

This book encourages self reflection as each Name is to be lived thus giving an opportunity to reflect upon our intentions and behaviours.

A name is a mark or a sign which serves as a symbol for the recognition of a person or a thing. We recognise something or someone by their name. A name evokes a wide possible range of opinions and emotions. The more knowledge you have of a thing or a person, the stronger the emotion when the name is called out. For instance, the words, ma, mum, mother, mummy, evoke love and affection whilst the word ghost evokes fear and mystery.

The power of a recognisable name is becoming increasingly valued and valuable. Consider the sponsorship at sporting events and the advertisements you see everywhere. In this case the name calls to mind goods of particular quality from a particular source.

When you remember someone's or something's name, you are paying them a subtle compliment. You are saying to them that they have made an impression on you, and it gives them a sense of importance. Similarly, when you do not recall someone's name it indicates their lack of impression on you. The word 'name' is therefore synonymous with the word 'reputation' or 'character' when it comes to human beings. Each of us has many names, the many names by which others know us. We have a different name (image, resonance, meaning) to all the different people with whom we interact. How do they see us? Who do they know us to be? Who does God know us to be? Do our names convey the names Integrity, Honesty, and Compassion? Do others look at us and think here comes Humour, Sensitivity, Caring?

We are born with some attributes, but the most important ones are those we develop as we grow. We can't change the colour of our skin, but we can learn to be kind.

تَخَلُّقُوابِأَخْلَاقِ الله :The Prophet said

Adopt in yourself the attributes of Allah.

Allah's attributes don't change. He stays the same - forever and ever. His Promises don't change, His Forgiveness is never taken back and His Love is forever. Whatever happens, He is always there. The acquiring of knowledge about the attributes of Allah is closely related to our knowledge of recognition of Allah.

The first human being on earth - Adam was taught 'all the names'.



'Teaching the names' means making the human being conscious of the essence of Divinity within him (the potential to attain the 'unlimited').

The names are hidden within us, and the challenge of life is to raise them into our consciousness and to live according to them.

It does not suffice to hear them, or read them, to recite them from memory or know their dictionary meanings for then we only know the name but not the Named. Each name of Allah is a Dua in itself.

The only way to know Allah is through His attributes. The attributes of Allah cannot be separated from Him. e.g., 'Ãlim -The one who is knowledgeable. Whilst a human being acquires knowledge and is still a human being even without knowledge, Allah is knowledge itself.

The word compassion (which means to be incredibly kind) comes from the Latin word compote which means to suffer together. Al Rahmaan never leaves you alone when you are hurting. Run into his arms and call out Ya Rahmaan when your wheart is hurting.



Al Rahmaan and Al Raheem are both related to Rahm which means 'the womb'. This is a sign that He is loving and protective, like a mother's womb round her baby. His kindness is all encompassing. But where Al Rahman is general and immediate, Al Raheem is particular, perpetual, and specific to those who submit to Divinity.

When it comes to His kindness, no sin is too big to forgive, no problem too large to dissipate and no deed too small to be rewarded.

#### TO BE EXTRA KIND TO THOSE WHO SUBMIT TO HIM

Al Rahman can be seen as the sun which is everywhere whilst Al Raheem is like the moon which has to be looked for in the night sky. Those who turn to Allah receive special kindness (mercy) from Al Raheem.



Al Raheem is the quality that Allah manifests to those who believe. He shows extra Mercy to those who use their free will to choose His way in order to be successful.

# REFLECTION

When we feel we have more burdens or problems than we can handle, it is Al Raheem who is calling us to rely on Him more.

Refuge is sought from it in Allah with the name Al Malik (The Absolute Owner)

The greeting is an identity for Muslims. The response is obligatory. When greeting someone with Salaam, we are also saying "May Allah always envelope you with His Name As Salaam" "As Salaam is a name from the names of Allah, so spread it between vourselves" Prophet (pbuh)



#### REFLECTION

We all move towards peace and tranquillity even without realising it. It could be through meditation, exercise, yoga or going for a walk on the beach or a park.

Some seek peace through salaa and dua (prayer) in connecting with Allah. And then there are others who try to escape agitation by seeking peace in destructive behaviour like drink and drugs. While the external practices may vary, in essence, we are all seeking the same thing.

True peace can only come from its source. We look for peace because something in our soul recognises the divine nature of this attribute.

Recite YAA SALAAM 100x for someone with an illness to heal and to be safe from all types of troubles.

#### REFLECTION

One is 'Azeez' amongst people when one is useful in matters that lead others to their personal best. The honour of each one of us is in proportion to our usefulness, accessibility, support and concern in guiding others.

Recite YAA 'AZEEZ especially after Fajr Salaa to gain honour and independence from creation and the ability to help others.

This is an attribute for the tyrants and oppressors to be aware of, because their misdeeds will not go unpunished. Yet this Name has another dimension: Al-Jabbar is the One who is able to restore and mend what is broken.



The word 'compel' comes from the Latin word 'compellere' which means to drive together. It used to be referred to a shepherd when he herded his cattle together into one place with the help of a sheepdog. The cattle found the sheep dog threatening but in reality, it was a protector who stopped them from getting separated.



#### REFLECTION

The Arabic word for a splint that is used to help an arm heal when it is broken is "Jabeera" from the same root jabara. Thus, when we feel broken, we need to go to the only One who can mend our state Al Jabbaar.

The Prophet (pbuh) went to Taaif to ask the people for their protection but instead they threw stones at him. until his feet bled. He called out to Allah:

"O Allah! To you alone I complain my weakness, my scarcity of resources, and the humiliation I have been subjected to by people. O Most Merciful of those who have mercy! You are the Lord of the weak, and You are My Lord too..."

It was the dua' of someone broken.

Divinity responded by sending a young boy by the name of Addaas who came to him with some grapes and kissed his bleeding feet. And Al Jabbar healed the broken heart of the Prophet in another way too. He bestowed upon him the journey to the heavens (Israa wal Mi'raaj).

#### **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA JABBAAR after Fajr Salaa to be safe from hardship and to enforce repair of a broken heart.

Some of the great scholars would supplicate "YAA JAABIRUL KASEER" when they were faced with overwhelming difficulty, meaning "Oh You who mends everything that is broken."

From this attribute comes the command to magnify Him through Takbeer (Allahu Akber) - Allah is Greater than anything or anyone (greater than whatever can be encompassed by any human comprehension, understanding or vision.



Whatever we are experiencing, Allah is greater. Al Mutakabbir breaks the limitations of pettiness in which we drown by letting go of the borders we create so that we may discover that His Greatness exists within and beyond these borders.



#### REFLECTION

Taking pride in what we do ensures that we do things to the best of our ability and shows us our worth. However, when we start thinking that we are better (greater) than everyone else, we forget that worth is not based on wealth, fame, race, or outer beauty but on righteousness. Human Arrogance is a sign of weakness and ignorance

Righteousness is recognising that only Allah is the Greatest (Al Mutakabbir)

Recite YAA MUTAKABBIR before every task to achieve success. Parents should recite YAA MUTAKABBIR for righteous children.

There are 37 trillion cells in our body. If you spread out an adult human's brain, it would be about the size of a pillowcase. The heart pumps 8,000 litres of blood around the body every day. We take around 17,000 breaths a day on average, and don't have to think about a single one of them.

Al Razzaaq is like parents with a child. Although there is still unconditional love and care, the child is taught by the parents the skills to feed themselves, walk, talk, dress and think for themselves.

Recite YAA RAZZAAQ repeatedly for ease in increasing sustenance and to relieve anxiety.

THE ALL KNOWING - HE KNOWS ABSOLUTELY EVERYTHING ABOUT EVERYTHING. HE KNOWS WHAT HAS HAPPENED, WHAT IS HAPPENING AND WHAT WILL HAPPEN FROM THE BEGINNING TO THE END.

"... And He has absolute knowledge of all things." 2:29

Al 'Aleem knows the hidden and the manifest, the secrets of the heart and soul, the small and the large, the intention and the action in its totality. He is not constrained by time and space.



The Arabic words **'aalam** (world), **'alam** (flag, symbol, sign), and **'ilm** (knowledge) all come from the same root. Our **world** is a **sign** of the source of **knowledge** - AL 'ALEEM. The more we reflect on the world around us as the Qur'an exhorts us to do, the more we will see the ALL KNOWING in every aspect. He knows who we are, what we do and what we need.

on His attributes through the awesomeness of creation is to understand His Perfection and Brilliance in contrast to our limitations and fallibility. That is in essence being knowledgeable. The Munajaat (whispered prayer) of Imam Ali (pbuh) reflects this beautifully.

## THE CONSTRICTOR - HE WHO RESTRICTS, TIGHTENS, CONTRACTS AND SHRINKS.

"...And Allah constricts and expands and to Him you shall be brought back." 2:245

Al Qaabidh is the one who applies pressure and restricts ease forcing the human being to see his virtues and making him turn inwards to his heart - making tears flow but bringing him closer to Allah.



The greatest Divine blessings often comes from the doors that Al Qaabidh closes. They are doors that lead to destruction, distraction and despair. By closing doors, He guides us to the doors that lead us to closeness to Him and peace, purpose and one's potential.



#### REFLECTION

A person was watching a butterfly struggling to emerge from its cocoon. Wanting to help he snipped the entrance of the cocoon to expand it for the butterfly. When the butterfly came out, its wings were laden with fluid and it was unable to fly. The struggle to come out of the restriction of the cocoon was meant to drain the fluid from its wings so it could soar in the sky.

Recite YAA QAABIDH frequently for protection from tyranny and hunger.

The Arabic word for carpet is bisaat which comes from the same root. If we reflect on all the threads that interlink to make the carpet, we can understand the connectedness to everything when there is expansion - to rise up in the air like a flying carpet Bisaat Ar Ruh (the carpet of the soul).

Al Baasit blows away sorrows and worries.



#### REFLECTION

Al Baasit also means to please. The Prophet (pbuh) said: "Fatima is part of me whatever pleases her pleases me, whatever displeases her displeases me" and the word he used was Bast. Al Baasit is the one who pleases the souls by making them happy or delighted.

Recite YAA BAASIT to attain peace of heart and be independent of others.

## AL QAABIDH & AL BAASIT



We see the signs of Al Qaabidh and Al Baasit in our lungs which are always expanding and contracting. When we breathe in, our lungs expand with air taking in oxygen and when we breathe out our lungs contract to release carbon dioxide.

When we are constricted with difficulties and sadness, it is an opportunity to get closer to Allah by showing patience. When we are expanded with joy and success, it is an opportunity to get closer to Allah by showing gratitude.





## MEANING

#### THE ONE WHO HUMBLES - THE ABASER WHO LOWERS US TO A PLACE WHERE HARD LESSONS ARE LEARNT.

"It (the day of judgement) will Humble and Raise." 56:3

Although painful, when Al Khaafidh humbles, it is a gift for those who see He Who is in control of humbling and elevating.



Firawn was a tyrant who bullied the Bani Israail. When Prophet Musa (pbuh) visited him with his brother asking for the Bani Israail to be freed he refused but relented every time Divinity sent a sign to humble his people. Eventually they left Egypt, but Firawn followed with his army. He saw the parting of the sea but even that did not deter him and he pursued Prophet Musa (pbuh) and the Bani Israail. Only when he was drowning, did he realise that that it is Allah who is Al Khaafidh (humbles) and Ar Raafi' (elevates) and he believed in the Master of Musa and Harun.

The Qur'an says about Firawn, "So today We will save you in body that you may be to those who succeed you a sign. And indeed, many among the people, of Our signs, are heedless".



#### REFLECTION

Yaa Khaafidh I desperately need you. Let me accept that the lessons You teach me through the abasement of my sins to see the elevation that forgiveness brings. You are my refuge from my own ego

## You are my refuge from my own ego (Edges God Out).

Recite YAA KHAAFIDH for protection of harm from others.

Al Muzhill is the one who teaches us that separation from Divinity cannot give peace, contentment, or satisfaction. The utmost level of dishonour is to be deluded that creation alone can bestow honour.



When our forehead touches the ground, it assists in understanding humility. It is from this place that we accept our powerlessness before Allah and understand the meaning of Al Muzhill.



### REFLECTION

The word 'humble' originates from the Latin word 'humilis' which means 'on the ground'. Thus a humble person is known as one 'who is down to earth'. Al Muzhill is He Who brings one who is arrogant 'down to earth'.



#### **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA MUZHILL to avert tyranny and fear none but Allah.

# AL MU'IZZ & AL MUZHILL

Salaa begins with the position of standing (qiyaam) which indicates the acknowledgement of Al Mu'izz - the one who gives honour. He created human beings with a position of honour as His representatives on earth.

Al Muzhill is reflected in sajda with our forehead on the earth denoting a humble position accepting His total authority over us.





وَإِذَيَرُفَحُ إِبْرُهِمُ ٱلْقَوَاعِدَمِنَ ٱلْبَيْتِ وَإِسْمَعِيلُ مَبَّنَا تَقَبَّلُ مِنَّاً إِنَّكَ أَنتَ ٱلسَّمِيحُ ٱلْعَلِيمُ

"And when Ibraheem and his son Ismaeel raised the foundation of the house (Ka'ba) - (they said) Our Rabb! Accept from us -Indeed You are All Hearing All Knowing" 2:127

Al Samee' is Perfect Hearing - He hears all that is said with the lips, felt by the heart and goes through the mind. No sound (audible or silent) is heard less that another though an infinite number of voices speak at the same time.



He hears even the deafening silence like the breaking of a heart.

The falling apart of a heart should make a loud noise. It should sound like a building crashing down. Not this kind of quiet just voiceless screams of the soul and the continuous shattering of the heart.



#### REFLECTION

يَامَنُ لَا يَحُتَاجُ إِلَي اتَّفْسِيْرِ

"O He Who does not need an explanation". (Extract from Dua taught to Imam Sajjad by Imam Husayn on the day of 'Ashura) When you raise your hands in dua to speak to Him; know that He can hear your silence even when you can't put your feelings into words.

Recite YAA SAMEE' to be 'heard' by others and for the fulfilment of wishes.



Al Baseer sees everything in such a way that nothing is remote from Him even when it is under the earth or up in the heavens. His Seeing is not restricted by time and distance.





"....He is not overcome by drowsiness or sleep..." 2:255

Doorbells and cameras that record images give us security in the home. They need battery changes whilst Allah is Ever Seeing and Ever Recording without any fatigue.



# REFLECTION

"My servant comes close to Me with his continuous devotion until I love him and when I love him I become his ears with which he hears and his eyes with which he sees and his tongue with which he speaks and his hand with which he holds." Hadith Qudsi

Al 'Adl is He Who creates perfect symmetry. The 99 names balance each other and Al 'Adl balances everything perfectly.



'Adl literally means to put everything in its rightful place. Sometimes 'adl is confused with equality. Equality is not a condition for justice, e.g., Justice in a classroom does not mean that all the students are given equal marks; but that marks are given according to ability and effort. Similarly, it would not be 'adl (justice) if a large oak tree was given the same roots as that of a small sapling.

"...And your Lord is not unjust to anyone."18:49 Scales are used to weigh and balance things. We each have a set of scales in our heart which tell us when things are out of balance (when we are being unjust). It is called our conscience.

Recite YAA 'ADL frequently for others to recognise the truth in you.

Al Lateef shows His love in ways that are subtle and hidden. His comprehension of the finest of details allows all the pieces to fit perfectly in the Divine puzzle. The pearl in the oyster, the silk in the silkworm, the honey in the bee and heart in the human being.



Al Lateef provides a softening energy of love and knowledge which turns that which is hard and coarse to soft, delicate and subtle to come closer to our true self and Divinity.

Al Lateef is the silver lining in the grey clouds which allows Divine light (energy) to shine through.



### REFLECTION

'As a raindrop fell from a cloud, it looked at the ocean and said "Who am I compared to this infinite sea?" The raindrops humility inspired the heart of an oyster to open its shell and let the raindrop inside transforming it into a beautiful pearl' Farid ud Den (Attar of Nishapur)



### **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite AL LATEEF frequently for healing from illnesses, relief from difficulties and pain in the body or soul. Reciting it in cycles of 129 repetitions is highly recommended.

Al Khabeer is aware of the inside and outside of everything. He is Aware of their beginning until their end. He is Aware of that which is being planned and is secret and not yet actualised.





"The knowledge (Awareness) of the self is the most useful of knowledge". Imam Ali (pbuh)

### REFLECTION

When mirrors are clean, they reflect every minute detail. When they are misty or dirty, they stop reflecting with clarity. The heart is like a mirror which can reflect all the attributes of Divinity. It gets misty and dirty with hatred, greed, pride, jealousy. Reaching out to Al Khabeer assists us to be aware of the dirt on the mirror and be able to clean it.



# **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA KHABEER for freedom from bad habits.



'Hilm' is a state of cheerful composure that cannot be shaken by inner anger or outside threats. A gentleness and softness which gives people time to change. Forgiveness is A PART OF 'HILM'.



Al Haleem is related to the Arabic word for 'dream'. He calms us in difficult situations connecting us to a deep hidden place of soothing dreams where we can put things into perspective.



### REFLECTION

When expelled from Taaif, the Prophet (pbuh) sat under a tree bleeding from the wounds where stones were thrown at him. The angels appeared and asked whether he would like them to be punished. The Prophet (pbuh) refused saying that maybe one day from their future generations there will be someone who will do good. He reflected the quality of Al Haleem The first person to introduce Islam to the Indian sub-continent was a descendant of the people of Taaif.



# **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA HALEEM to put anger into perspective and subside it. Recite it to restore affection.



# MEANING

#### THE AWESOME - THE ONE WHOSE AWESOMENESS IS PERFECTION PERSE. HE IS AWESOME (PERFECT) IN EVERT ATTRIBUTE.

فَسَبِّحُ بِاسْمِ مَبِّكَ الْعَظِيمِ

"So declare the Perfection of the name of your Master, The Awesome" 56:96

Al Azheem comes from the same root word as making bones stronger. His Awesomeness is felt in the 'bones' - our very foundation. His Awesomeness carries 'weight'.

I declare the Perfection of my Master, The Awesome and I praise Him. His Awesomeness makes us bow in awe of Him.

Had We sent down this Quran upon a mountain, you would have seen it humbled [and] crumble in awe of Allah. We draw such comparisons for human beings so that they may reflect. 59:21 If we ponder over the awesomeness of Al Azheem, and feel it in our bones, we too may be humbled and strengthen our bond with Him.

Al Azheem comes from an Arabic word meaning to grow strong bones.

Recite YAA AZHEEM frequently for success, honour and protection.

THE REWARDER OF THANKFULNESS - THE ONE WHO APPRECIATES ACKNOWLEDGES, REWARDS AND INCREASES EVEN THE SMALLEST OF EFFORTS. AL-SHAKUR ACCEPTS LITTLE AND GIVES A LOT IN EXCHANGE. HE ALSO REWARDS HIS SERVANTS FOR THANKING HIM.

"Declare the Perfection of the name of your Master, The Most High" 87:1 When this verse was revealed, the Prophet (pbuh) said it should be recited in Sujood and thus we say:

سُبْحَانَ رَبِّي الْأَعْلُو بِحَمْدِهِ

I declare the Perfection of my Master, The Most High and I praise Him.

Sajda (prostration) is the position in which we are at our lowest in a position of humility. In this position without the forehead touching the earth, we become aware of our lowliness in comparison to Him being The Most High.



# REFLECTION

"Come! Raise yourself to Me! Don't live below your potential".

Al 'Ali is higher than anything or anyone that we can imagine.

Practical steps:

- 1. Do wudhoo.
- 2. Go on your musalla and switch off the phone, watch and computer.
- 3. Pray Salaa and recite Qur'an.
- 4. Talk to Him in the silence imagining you are at the top of the highest mountain you can climb.

Recite YAA 'ALI frequently to achieve success in all your endeavours.

"And Indeed Allah is The Most High, The Great." 22:62

No matter what one is going through, Allah is Greater than it. Thus the Kabeer (big) problem becomes sagheer (small) because there is Al Kabeer to solve it. Al Kabeer is One whose Essence is Greatness. Al Mutakabbir is One Who reveals His Greatness at every moment.



From this attribute and the attribute of Al Mutakabbir (19) comes the command to magnify Him through Takbeer (Allahu Akber) - Allah is Greater than anything or anyone (greater than whatever can be encompassed by any human comprehension, understanding or vision.

# اَللَّهُ اَكْبَر

Allah is Greater than anything or anyone.

The most repeated phrase in the day of a Muslim. Throughout the 5 daily prayers and in the tasbee of Sayyida Fatima (pbuh). It is a statement derived from Al Kabeer and initiates the salaa so one's mind is not occupied by anyone or anything but Him, nor will the heart be attached to anyone or anything but Him.

One of the earliest commandments in the Qur'an is

Allah is Greater than anything or anyone. Allahu Akber is the first phrase we hear when we enter the world. It is a phrase to be repeated on every occasion - difficult or happy. Greatness belongs to Al Kabeer alone.

"Having the Greatness of the Creator in your mind would make you realise the insignificance of the creatures in your view." Imam Ali (pbuh)



Recite AL KABEER frequently to be cured of aliments and to gain self-esteem.



Al Hafeezh comes from the root word - 'hafazha' from which the word 'hifzh' memorisation comes.



...وَلَا يَنُو دُهُ حِفْظُهُمَا...

"...and He does not get tired by their preservation..." 2:255

The entire universe and everything and everyone in it is preserved by Allah; He doesn't forget even the smallest thing and He doesn't get tired. The laws of the universe like the law of gravity only work because Al Hafeezh preserves them - if He were to sleep or forget them, there would be utter chaos.



#### REFLECTION

A book is called hafeezh because its contents safeguard records of actions and statements from being lost. Hifzh (memorisation) is a form of preservation and remembrance. In Arabic, remembrance is called Zhikr. Repeating (doing Zhikr) of the names of Allah (Asmaul Husnaa) enables preservation of eiman, gratitude and trust in Divinity.

Recite AL HAFEEZH frequently to be protected from calamities and hostility.



TO ITS NEEDS (BOTH BODY AND SOUL).

وَكَانَ اللَّهُ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ مُقِيتًا

"...And Allah Nourishes all things." 4:85

'Qoot' (from which the word Muqeet is derived) means the personalised nourishment that each body and soul requires. The soul receives nourishment in the form of knowledge and love. He makes accessible what each creature requires for the nourishment of its body and soul.



One of the signs of Al Muqeet is the milk that flows from a mother to her young. All of creation is provided for in different ways. Rumi says: The dove on the tree coos gratefulness, even though her food for the night has not yet arrived. The nightingale's glorification is this: "I

depend for my daily bread, on You who loves to respond." The falcon delights in the King's hand, and no longer looks at carrion.

Look at every animal from the gnat to the elephant: they all are God's family, and dependent on Him for their food. What a nourisher is God! (Al Muqeet)



#### REFLECTION

There is a difference between need and the acquisition of that which is beyond necessity and possibly harmful to us and the earth. To manifest the quality of Al Muqeet, we need to understand what really nourishes us. The Qur'an and the Ahlul Bayt have taught us what best nourishes and poisons our bodies and souls.



# **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite AL MUQEET frequently for safety on a journey. For Divine assistance in combating ill manners in a child, recite AL MUQEET 7x on water and give it to the child to drink.





# MEANING

THE ACCOUNTER WHO TAKES ACCOUNT OF EVERYTHING APPARENT AND HIDDEN AND CALCULATES PRECISELY. HE WHO IS NOT FOOLED BY APPEARANCES. THE ONE TO WHOM WE ARE ACCOUNTABLE TO AND THE ONE WHO SUFFICES.

#### REFLECTION

The greatest gift we have been given is life (time) which we spend with every breath we take. Life is about obedience to the Creator and serving His creation. On the day of Accounting (Qiyaama) we will be accountable to Al Haseeb for every moment.

"Call your own selves to account before you yourselves are called on to account for them." Prophet Muhammad (pbuh)

If it remains firm in its place, only then will you see Me." When his Master made apparent His Might to the mountain, it crumbled to dust and Musa fainted. When he recovered, he cried, "I declare Your Perfection! I turn to You in repentance, and I am the first of the believers." 7:143

# MEANING

THE GENEROUS ONE WHOSE IS THE SOURCE OF ALL GENEROSITY. HIS CONSTANT BLESSINGS SURPASS ALL EXPECTATIONS. HE GIVES WITHOUT BEING ASKED, WITHOUT REASON OR WHETHER ONE DESERVES IT OR NOT. AL KAREEM IS THE GENEROUS FORGIVER WHO ACCORDS NOBILITY TO THOSE WHO SEEK REFUGE IN HIM.

لَا إِلٰهَ إِلَّهُ وَمَبَّ الْعَرْشِ الْكَرِيمِ

"....there is no god except Him, the Generous Master of the Throne." 23:116

Al-Kareem is He who has made Himself accessible. He does not require that you make an appointment with Him, nor does He stipulate the usage of a particular language when communicating with Him. He does not limit what you can ask for, nor for how long you can stay.

He watches every action, intention, emotion, feeling and thought. Nothing escapes Him.

"Worship Allah as though you see Him, and though you do not see Him, you know that He sees you" Prophet Muhammad (pbuh)



#### REFLECTION

... No leaf falls without His knowing it... 6:59

If He can watch every leaf that falls from every tree in the universe, then we can be rest assured that Al Raqeeb is constantly watching over every aspect of our existence as a mother does - without judgement but gently correcting where necessary. The more precious the person, the more watchful we are to protect and nurture.

Recite YAA RAQEEB for Divine protection.

#### REFLECTION

The story of Prophet Yusuf (pbuh) shows the Wisdom of Al Hakeem. It is not possible to understand the hardships he went through until we look at them after the events had occurred. In the end, Prophet Yusuf (pbuh) saved the people of Egypt from famine, attained immense success, and was reunited with his family. The dream he had in his childhood of seeing the sun, moon and stars prostrating to him (12:4) came true. He believed in the wisdom of Al Hakeem and knew that it would all connect in the future but never exactly knew how.



#### **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA HAKEEM frequently to overcome difficulties.



إِنَّ اللَّهَ وَاسِعٌ عَلِيحٌ

"Ask Your Master for forgiveness, then turn to Him repentant, Indeed My Master is Kind & Loving." 11:90

No Matter what you have done or said, Allah is waiting for you or return to Him so He can enfold you with His Forgiveness and Love. Every time you go astray, return to Him for He is always there, waiting for you. When we love someone, we want to be close to them. The love of AL WADOOD is so Intense and Continuous that He is closer to us than our jugular vein (50:16)



Like our individual thumbprints, we all have a unique part to play in Creation. Without anyone of us, the world would be incomplete just like a jigsaw puzzle. Each one of us was created intentionally with a Divine purpose.

#### REFLECTION

We are programmed to incline towards those who reflect Divine Attributes. The difference between Hubb & Wudd which are both translated as love is that Hubb pertains to love in the heart whilst Wudd is much more extensive in that it is love in the heart accompanied by actions to bring the beloved closer.

Recite YAA WADOOD frequently to resolve differences.

Qaaf! I swear by the glorious Quran. 50:1 Divinity calls the Quran Al Majeed. Just as Al Majeed makes the impossible possible, the Qur'an is a miracle in itself. Its language, its effect on the heart and soul, and its preservation (every dot and line). It is a reminder that if we want to witness the miracle of Al Majeed we only need to open the Qur'an.



## REFLECTION

Al-Majeed means Allah is above all limitations, there are no obstacles to His decree, no matter how impossible it seems in our eyes. So, when we do dua, we should know that Allah can make miracles happen.



## **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA MAJEED frequently to witness His Glory and to increase spiritual capacity.



Our bodies will eventually die, but our souls live forever. After our bodies have died, we rise again in new bodies on the day of Resurrection.

Recite YAA BAAITH frequently to awaken the heart to Divine Guidance.



"Soon We shall show them Our signs in the horizons and in their own souls until it becomes clear to them that He is the Truth. Is it not sufficient that your Master is Witness to all things?" 41:53

Everything bears witness to His creation. Al Shaheed transforms us into witnesses and makes us aware of the Divine Presence.



The words Tashahhud and Shahaada (witnessing the truth)

Recite YAA SHAHEED frequently to dispel bad habits and open the heart to light and understanding.

"O Allah, show me the truth of things as they truly are." Dua taught by the Prophet (pbuh)



Each verse of the Qur'an is called an Aayaa (pl Aayaat) which means a sign. The signs (aayaat, verses) of the Qur'an lead us to The Truth. Only Truth is constant and real.



## REFLECTION

وَقُلْ جَاءَ الْحُقُّ وَزَهَنَ الْبَاطِلُ إِنَّ الْبَاطِلَ كَانَ زَهُوقًا

"And say, The truth has come, and falsehood has vanished. Indeed falsehood is bound to vanish." 17:81 Divine Truth gives freedom by breaking the shackles of delusion (baatil) and its manifestation appears as one who always speaks the truth, listens and believes in it and that is when all falsehood disappears. Truth will always remain the truth and will eventually prevail.

Recite YAA HAQQ frequently to receive unexpected help and support. Also recite to find that which is lost.



Allah knowing that whatever we experience (blessing or test) is a means to get closer to Him and ultimately to our personal best.



To trust Him is to hand over our problems to Him after we have done our best for the Prophet (pbuh) said:

"If you were to rely on Allah as He should be relied on, He would provide for you as He provides for the birds. They go out early in the morning hungry and return in the evening full".

For every broken heart that silently shatters.

For every pain that you can't explain. For every fear and worry that consumes you.

The intensity of the strength, capacity and power of Al Qawiyy enables us to offer Him the weight of the world on our shoulders, knowing He will be the strength to carry our burdens.



Al Qawiyy shows us the smallness of everything and everyone in the universe in the face of the Divine.

Our strength comes from Him and Him alone. Imam Husayn (pbuh) on the day of Ashura said:

Al Mateen does not need an army to enforce His authority. He needs no help, nor supporters, nor assistants. His Might is perfect; nothing in the heavens nor on earth can stand in His way. He affects everything yet nothing can affect Him.



#### REFLECTION

"Indeed, this religion is Mateen, so enter its depth with gentleness." Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) Standing firm is not synonymous with being stubborn or harsh. "Show gentleness, for if gentleness is found in anything, it beautifies it and when it is taken out from anything it damages it." Prophet Muhammad (pbuh)



## **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA MATEEN frequently to gain strength in difficult times. Recite it with YAA QAWIYY to assist the physical body to gain strength.

"Allah is the Protective Friend of those who believe: He brings them out of darkness into light..." 2:257

It is not just external protection that Al Waliyy gives but also the internal strength and tranquillity that enables us to withstand every hardship.



The root word of Al-Waliyy means to be very close without any barrier. It connotes closeness, guardianship and one who supports.



## REFLECTION

"I whisper to You, O You who is present in every place so that You may hear my call. My sins are excessive and my shame little...

I call for help from desires which have overpowered me...

I come to You alone..... my actions around my neck, when all of creation will withdraw from me....

Then if You do not have mercy on me, who will?

Who will give me solace from the

loneliness of my grave?

Who will help me speak when I am alone with my deeds?..."

#### REFLECTION

The Prophet (pbuh) advised us to say ALHAMDULILLAH (All Praise and Gratitude belongs to Allah) at every occasion, knowing that everything is praiseworthy even if the ego fails to understand. To know that we do not know is the beginning of understanding Al Hameed. Just as Sayyida Zaynab said after the event of Karbala MAA RA'AYTU ILLAA JAMEELAA (I saw nothing but beauty)



## **BENEFITS OF ZHIKR (REMEMBRANCE)**

Recite YAA HAMEED frequently in times of difficulty and need to feel the Divine force within.



## MEANING

#### THE APPRAISER - THE ONE WHO ANALYSES, COUNTS AND RECORDS, NOTHING GETS LOST WITH AL MUHSI. HE KNOWS THE TRUE VALUE OF EVERYTHING VISIBLE AND INVISIBLE.

أَحْصَالُا اللَّهُوَنَسُوةُ وَاللَّهُ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَى<sub>ْ</sub> مِشَهِيدٌ

"...Allah has kept a count of it, while they have forgotten, and Allah is witness to all things." 58:6

Al Muhsi is the One who knows everything inside and outside in detail and then records the results which never get forgotten. Even the smallest of deeds is recorded. Every good deed is coming back tenfold and a bad deed only once.



The English word computer comes from the Latin word 'computare', which means 'to calculate', 'to count', 'to think', or 'to sum up'. The counting and recording of a computer are minuscule compared to Al Muhsi who also knows the true value of everything.



## REFLECTION

"...If you count Allah's blessings, you will not be able to appraise them...." 14:34 Al Muhsi gives us the capacity to see the blessings in every aspect of life.

## AL MUBDI' & AL MUEED

We see the signs of Al Mubdi' and Al Mu'eed when we see a circle. When we begin something (AL MUBDI'), we set it in motion like the first half of the circle and when we restore it (AL MU'EED) we put it back where it came from and that represents the second half of the circle.





"How can you deny Allah; you were lifeless, and He gave you life, then He will make you die and then bring you to life, and then you will be brought back to Him?" 2:28

Nothing can live without Al Muhyi. Each living thing is only alive because Allah has given it life.

It is Al Mumeet who determines the time and place of death. What we can do is live the one life we have been given to submit to Divinity and serve His creation.

Just as Al Hayy occupies a high position so does Al Qayyum.

The Arabic word Qayyum is related to Qiyaam which is the standing position in salaa (prayers). When we stand in salaa it is apt to know that we are being supported by Al Qayyum.



## REFLECTION

Al Qayyum gives a sense of total dependence. Just like the navel which reminds us how we were supported in our mother's womb by the umbilical cord.

The simile is like looking at the waves on the ocean. All the different waves are part of one ocean. Al Ahad is like being in the depths of the ocean where there are no waves and feeling only the oneness around you.

He is One in His Attributes: He resembles nothing and nothing resembles Him." All qualities exist in Him in their perfect state.

## REFLECTION

A wall is made of bricks, water, sand, cement and more. However, when we look at it we see it as a wall. The wall is the sum of all its parts - the materials lost their identity individually in the wall. As human beings we identify ourselves as 'l' yet within the 'l' there are many characteristics, thoughts, values - in other words many 'l's.

The identity of everything in creation is constructed in the same way Al Ahad (the Unique) reflects unity in multiplicity.

Recite YAA AHAD frequently to manifest (reveal) hidden things (recommended to recite it 1000x in solitude).



Al Samad is in essence is the final destination, the ultimate goal. The One Whom we seek in times of need. He is the completeness of all potentials.

The Arabs describe a household of Samad where people go in the hope of fulfilling their worldly needs.

Whenever Prophet Zakariyya (pbuh) visited Sayyida Maryam who was under his protection, he saw fruits out of season in her room. He asked here where they were from. She replied *"It is from Allah..."* 3:37 There and then, Zakariyya asks Allah at the age of 75 for a child.

"There and then did Zakariyya call out to His Master; He said: My Master ! grant me from You a righteous child; surely You are the Hearer of prayer." 3:38

Al Qaadir granted him Yahya although his wife was old and had no previous children.



#### REFLECTION

Allah created the universe as a mirror to reflect His Power without the help of anything or anyone from nothing. His power of creation and causing things to happen is conditioned by only One thing -His Will. That is Al Qaadir.

Al Muqtadir (the Creator of All Power) completes Al Qaadir (the One Who makes anything possible through His Will) Both come from the root word 'q d r' which means to know the measure of something, to ordain, to decide a matter, to intend or determine something, to have the power, to accomplish, to be able, to be able to prevail, to be empowered. Both refer to possessing power or being capable. Al Qaadir possesses infinite power whilst Al Muqtadir exercises His Power over everything. Al Muqtadir is more forceful.

All around we see the power that Allah has given human beings like buildings and bridges. Yet despite our technology we are still frail. Compared to Al Qaadir and Al Muqtadir our power is minute.





Al Muqaddim enables us to go ahead, step by step without losing sight of the goal of reaching our full potential with Divine guidance.

## REFLECTION

Al Muqaddim enables us to recognise that everything happens at the right moment teaching us to deal with time and our impatience.

Al Awwal is the One Who exists eternally beyond time and space. He created in order to be known. He was before everything, and He is the One Who created everything.

Recite YAA AWWAL frequently to see the truth and find solutions to overwhelming problems.




Al Aakhir is post eternity. He is the Last without an end.

Encounter with Jibraail and a mode of transport called Buraq. Divinity shows His signs to His most awesome slave - Muhammad (pbuh) Sidratul Muntahaa - Tree at the boundary of where even Jibraail could not go. The closer you get to Al Muta'aali the higher the ascension and the more secrets Divinity reveals to you.



# REFLECTION

Each of us has a higher self and a lower self. The lower self is like a mask we put on when we cannot find the higher self which is what connects to Divinity. The higher self-wishes to serve Creation whilst the lower self only thinks about itself.

To be able to ascend towards success is to be able to be selfless and develop the higher self.

When you do good to Allah's creation, even if it is by a kind word or a smile, you see the reflection of Al Barr. Al Barr shows kindness to those who oppose Him. He forgives those who ask for forgiveness, and He accepts their apologies. He covers our mistakes and weaknesses. He is the One Whose blessings never end, even when the blessed one lives in rebellion.

He fills the heart with joy and heals it.

# REFLECTION

Al Muntaqim is all about accountability. When we are selfish and unjust, we are really punishing ourselves. Our selfishness makes us support oppression and exploitation and it is Al Muntaqim who is the avenging campaign against our ego making it stop seeing itself as the centre of the universe.

"Be merciful to those on the earth, and the One above the heavens will have mercy on you." Prophet (pbuh) On the day of Judgement, Allah will ask "O son of Adam, I was sick but you did not visit me."

The human being will say "O my Master, You are the Master of the world, how could I have visited you?"

Allah will say "One of My servants was sick but you did not visit him; had you visited him, you would have found Me by him."

The 99 names of Allah have sometimes been divided into names of Majesty and Power (Jalaal names) and the names of Beauty and Generosity (Jamaal Names). Dhul Jalaal wal Ikraam creates a balance between these two types of names.

Recite YAA DHUL JALAAL was Ikraam every day and whenever you are begging for something from Allah.



Lots of times things that happen do not seem fair to us. From our limited view we don't see the big picture and how things will eventually be, especially in the aakhira (after life). Those who stand for justice, human rights and human dignity are the best signs of Al Muqsit. One who embodies Al Muqsit does not abuse his power and position.



# REFLECTION

Equality is giving everyone an equal share whilst equity is to give according to individual needs.

Every mother loves her children equally, yet every child needs a different kind of attention.

Every week Muslims gather on Yawmul Jumua' (Day of gathering) – Friday. Once a year Muslims from all over the world gather to do the hajj that bears witness to their commitment to their faith. On YAWMUL JAM'AA (The Day of Gathering) The Day of Judgement -

- 1. The oppressed will be gathered together with the oppressor to exact justice
- 2. Every messenger will be gathered with his nation

Both refer to the elimination of need from all except Allah. Al Ghaniyy (The Rich) refers to the essence of Allah whilst Al Mughniy (The Enricher) is the action that Al Ghaniyy (The Rich) takes.

The greatest richness is the ability to reach one's full potential by flowing Divine Guidance.



Kawthar and Takaathur allude to abundance but express two diametrically opposite states. Takaathur is covetous greed whilst Kawthar is limitless abundant goodness from divinity.

Similarly, Allah is the ruling governing body over this world and the hereafter and punishment is for those who cross the line and cause harm.

## **INTRODUCTION** TO MNEMONICS

وَلِلَّهِ الْأَسْمَاءُ الْحُسْنَى فَادْعُو كُبِهَا

"Allah's are the best of names, so call on Him thereby." 7:180

The 99 names of Allah (Asmaul Husna) can be memorised in sequence using the Link system.

The Link system of memory is designed to enable one to remember any number of things in sequence. The process is divided into three stages:

- Encoding the elements of information into visual images as image information is far easier to memorise than textual information.
- 2. The memorisation process itself.
- 3. Remembering the sequence of information.

Mnemonics (pronounced ne-monik) is a memory aid in the form of a word, phrase or story. It is derived from a Greek word 'mnemonikon' – an art of memorisation.

For example, most of us are able to remember the colours of the rainbow by using a mnemonic such as 'Richard of York gave battle in vain'.

Here the initial letters of the seven words give us the colours: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo and violet. This example demonstrates two elements of memorisation: imagination and association. Thus, you create a sentence (imagination) using words starting with the initial letters of the colours (association). Aristotle wrote, as the first sentence of one of his books, "In order to think we must speculate with images."

The 99 names have been divided into 11 sections to allow easy memorisation. The first step is to create focus points or 'pegs' for each section on which we can 'hang' the story mnemonics.

On the following pages you will find the focus points and the corresponding story mnemonics.
