








THE HAPPIEST TEN YEARS OF MUSA'S LIFE

- 3. Write a paragraph on how each person in this little group of travellers must be going through in this long, dark and cold night in the middle of the desert!










THE BURNING BUSH

- 5. Which 2 things did Musa say he will bring to his family?










MOUNT SINAL

- 5. In which chapter does Allah swear by The Mount Sinai?










ON MOUNT SINAI

- 9. Keep up prayer for remembrance.





- 5. When Musa (pbuh) pressed his hand under his armpit, what happened?










MIRACLES OF MUSA (PBUH)

Musa (pbuh) is asked to go to Firawn with these two miracles.










MUSA (PBUH) INSTRUCTED TO MEET FIRAWN

- 3. Who is Haroon and how is he related to Musa (pbuh)?










ALLAH REASSURES MUSA (PBUH)

forth his hand which was white and bright.


Firawn got scared and angry. He told those around him that Musa was a skillful magician and that all this is magic.

He told them that if Prophet Musa (pbuh) defeats them, then he would confirm Musa's prophethood.



- Accepting Musa's prophethood?



Musa said to the people that he will ask Allah to help reveal the murderer.










MUSA (PBUH) IN SURA BAQARA
