Namrud is the ruler of Mesopotamia (modern day Iraq) from the capital Kutha. He was the first king to mint gold and silver coins. Thought he was god. Closest advisor was
Aazar - an astrologer
who told him that a
child would be born
who would destroy his
empire and bring a
new religion.


An order was given to separate all couples except those associated with the king and Aazar.

Aazar's brother Terah and his wife conceived a child Sarah gave birth to Ibraheem on the 1st of Dhulhijja and smuggled him out of the city and raised him in a cave.

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Terah died a few years later and Sarah married Aazar












QUESTIONING THE IDOLS

P Ibraheem asks the priests about the gods they worship. 26:69-74



Aazar intervenes and says the idols are only representations of the true gods of Kutha he promised Ibraheem that he would introduce him to the true gods.













AAZAR INTERVENES

Only a small number believed amongst them his cousin Saarah and her brother Lut and their mother Waraqaa who was his mother's sister.


P Ibraheem married his cousin Saarah, and she gifted him her fortune inherited from her father. He became the wealthiest man in Kutha














P. IBRAHEEM SMASHES THE IDOLS



PRIESTS ARE RILED




The priests didn't have an answer and riled the crowd to shout out in protest to burn him to help their gods


FIRE IS PREPARED



Over the next few days on the order of Namrud and Aazar a towering structure was built with a fire pit within it that no one could come near. A catapult was also constructed to hurl him into the fire.

All the people of Kutha were called to gather and the fire was lit. P Ibraheem was placed in the catapult, and he called out to Al Waahid, As Samad asking Him to be delivered from the fire with the Waseela of Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) & his progeny


















Namrud ordered his guards to bring Ibraheem to him and asked him, "who is your Rabb?"

Namrud said he could do that and killed one and reprieved another. Ibraheem asked him to bring the sun from the west... 2:258

















Namrud was furious and exiled him and those who were with him - amongst them his cousin Lut. They left Kutha with a dua







P. IBRAHEEM TRAVELS











P. IBRAHEEM TRAVELS

Prophet Ibraheem (pbuh) was the first person to make undergarments and make and wear shoes as taught by God.













P. IBRAHEEM SENDS LUT



When he hears of trouble in the city of Sodom (near the sea of galilee) where the people had resorted to abducting young men for sexual purposes. He sent Lut there to guide them.




















SUHUF IBRAHEEM






Saarah was upset and struggling so Allah tells Prophet Ibraheem to take Hajra to Bakka (modern day Makka) so as not to upset Saarah more.

Ibraheem leaves Hajra and his young son in the desert valley of Bakka with some food and water.


Hajra asks him why he would leave her in such a barren place. With tears in his eyes he said, "The One who has ordered me to do so will look after you"






ZAMZAM











SAYYIDA HAJRA DIES



Hajra died soon after and Ismaail was distraught, he buried her near the Ka'ba known as Hijr Ismaail (the skirt of Ismaail)













When death approached him - he asked the angel of death whether a friend would ever take the life of a friend. Divinity replied saying, "Would a friend ever dislike meeting his friend?"












